Welcome

As the industry has adapted to the ongoing impact of the pandemic in 2021, we have seen many aspects of our working lives change. One positive outcome has been the renewed focus by companies on the importance of diversity, equity and inclusion.

In 2021, we were pleased to reinforce the importance of this shift with a transformation of our own from Women Talk Real Estate to Diversity Talks Real Estate. After four successful years of improving the visibility of female professionals through our speakers' database and training initiatives, we expanded our platform to ethnic minority professionals of all genders and other under-represented groups.

We launched Diversity Talks Real Estate in the second half of 2021 and are pleased to have already attracted speakers from a number of underrepresented groups. The feedback from the industry has been extremely positive, and we have been very grateful for the support we have received from sponsors and other industry partners.

Event organisers continued to make use of the database as we experienced another year of mainly online events. Overall, we saw 192 invitations extended to our experts. This brings our total since inception to 858 invitations to 332 different speakers.

As part of our rebrand, we have continued with Women Talk Real Estate as it serves an important community for our training and other female-led initiatives. In 2021, we continued to be an important resource for women looking for training and provided ten courses, training over 281 women across the year. We also re-launched the *Speakers Café* programme in an online format to provide an opportunity for women to practice public speaking.

For the coming year, we plan to focus on increasing the number of speakers from ethnic minority backgrounds and other under-represented groups. We also hope to be back in the room for training in 2022, including revisiting plans for a course on supporting women to become non-executive directors and developing a new course on leadership skills.

We would like to thank all those companies and individuals that continue to support us. In particular, we are grateful to our sponsors, who enable us to offer our speaker platform as a free resource to the industry.




WOMEN TALK REAL ESTATE Initiatives for female professionals

These regular events allow women to sign up to be on panels or present a short keynote in front of a supportive audience. We also provide tips and techniques as well as feedback for the speakers.





We continue to offer training courses designed to ensure that female professionals have access to the right resources to help them improve their public presence and increase their visibility.

Most of our training courses can be delivered in-house. We can also tailor our courses to suit company's needs.


